We started again on 18th January and everyone was so happy to be back. We had a fantastic afternoon! The smiles on the faces was a delight.

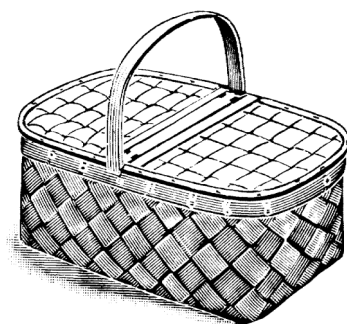
