Kids Ministry Coordinator

Birkenhead Community Church

Job Purpose

To serve the mission of Birkenhead Community Church to 5-11 year olds by coordinating activities which help them grow a personal relationship with Jesus, learn to live like Jesus and introduce their friends and family to the Christian faith.

Accountability

All ministries at BCC are ultimately accountable to the elders, under God, who appoint pastors and a leadership group to help with the running of the events. The coordinator is accountable to the elders and managed by the Pastor and supported by other members of the leadership group.

Hours

The role will be remunerated as a salaried position with a pro-rata annual salary of \$50k-\$60k depending on experience and the roles included. The hours are flexible up from a minimum of 1 day per week to a full time position depending on the roles to be covered.

NB. This role is designed to work closely with the person overseeing our youth ministry. We are recruiting for both roles simultaneously so specifics will be negotiated for both roles as we go.

Functions

The following functions are illustrative:

- Source and/or design curriculum for Kidzchurch with the support and direction of the Elders
- Recruit, train and empower a team of leaders from within BCC to take ownership of Kidzchurch
- Chair kids ministry steering group and provide a link between them and the Elders
- Get to know the children, overseeing the child protection procedures, data collection and record keeping
- Supporting the leadership of ministries for pre-school, Intermediate & High school children
- Champion the work of God among children at BCC implication of being at 90% or more of the Sunday services .
